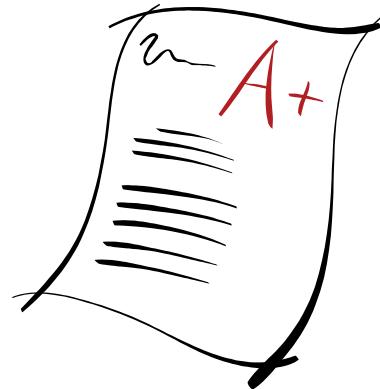
Grading

* FFA is an extension of the agriculture classroom where students apply classroom knowledge in real-world settings. Alternative assignments will be provided to students who chose not to participate in FFA activities.

Classroom Policies

Additional Expectations

Absences

Shop Safety

Students are only allowed in the woods and welding shops with instructor consent. When working in the shops, students will be required to pass safety tests for any tools and equipment that will be used. Students will also be required to wear safety goggles when in the shop.

Students who violate classroom policies will be subject to the following consequences:

- First violation Immediate 15 minute cleaning session
- Second violation 1-page reflective paper and trip to detention
- Third violation Long form and parent meeting

- Due to the nature of this course, it may be necessary to take educational field trips during the class period. Permission slips will be required for any trips that are longer than the assigned class period.
- On occasion, short clips from feature films such as Remember the Titans (PG), Hoosiers (PG), Footloose (PG), etc. may be shown during class. All film clips will be pertinent to the day's lesson and will not exceed a rating of PG-13 (*per School District policy*).
